



## Dubai Salons Opening Guidelines

Salons in Dubai have introduced waiting lists to cope with demand following the recent ease on movement restrictions in the city.

Re-opening of salons and barbershops are allowed as long as strict precautions are in place for the protection of public health and safety:

- Sterilisation procedures are taking place in each salon and barbershop according to Dubai Municipality guidelines and will continue during your visit.
- Regulations mean salons will operate with 30 per cent of staff at any one time.
- Clients must make a booking in advance with the salon or barbers as no walk-ins will be allowed access.
- Clients will be spaced at least 2 metres apart in the salon so fewer numbers will be appointed at specific times.
- All clients and staff must always wear a face mask - this is mandatory.
- Services available are restricted to hair cutting and colouring and manicures and pedicures only.
- No requests for waxing, brows, facials and massage services will be appointed until further government notifications are received.
- Clients will have a temperature check on entry and it is requested should you have been in contact with anyone who has the virus within the last 2 weeks to not visit the salon until you have completed the self-isolation process.
- All equipment used in the salon will be sterilised and all stations, basins and chairs cleaned after each client.
- Refreshments will be served as bottled water or in a paper disposable cup.
- Hand sanitiser will be available throughout the salon.
- Salons are officially allowed to open from noon to 10pm, but individual locations may vary their timings within those hours.
- According to official rules, all preventive and health measures must always be strictly observed in every salon and barbershop.
